
1) Have you ever wanted someone else's job because it seemed like the perfect job?



2) Have you ever criticized the way someone did his or her job and thought that you could have done it better?




3) Two men that worked on a train thought those things about each other.

10) "Sam!" he shouted. "You'll have to come help me! I can't make the train go!"




11) "Of course not!" replied Sam. "I didn't know how to steer and it fell off the tracks!"
